Meetings	When any of the following warning signals is hoisted or an announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be issued within 3 hours before the meeting starts

- ✧ During meetings, if the Hong Kong Observatory issued a **Black** Rainstorm Warning Signal, the meetings will continue. Participants are recommended to stay until the condition is safe.
- ✧ During meetings, if the Hong Kong Observatory announces a Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal **No.8 (or above)** will be issued within the meeting period, Corps Officers may conclude the meeting earlier that the participants may leave safely.
- ✧ In order to avoid accidents, participants should always pay attentions to the weather conditions of the places they may pass.
- ✧ If serving individuals are unable to attend according to the adverse weather conditions, please inform Corps Officers or Local Officers in-charge as soon as possible.
