

### 3. Service Targets

- 3.1 Facing housing problem, Hong Kong adult (male only) resident;
- 3.2 Facing financial difficulties;
- 3.3 Capable of self-care;
- 3.4 No infectious disease (definition of infectious disease: please refer to Center for Health Protection, Department of Health – [www.chp.gov.hk/](http://www.chp.gov.hk/));
- 3.5 With a concrete long-term accommodation plan.



### 4. Facilities

- 4.1 Five air-conditioned (charges apply) dormitories (bunk-beds)
- 4.2 Lockers (for storing personal belongings);
- 4.3 Shower rooms, toilets and pantry;
- 4.4 Sitting and dining room with newspaper and television;
- 4.5 Fire security system;
- 4.6 Cooking is not allowed, Microwave is provided for food reheat;
- 4.6 CCTV is installed at the common area for security purpose;
- 4.7 24-hour service and no curfew

### 5. Activities

- 5.1 Free activities: residents' meeting (once per month) for residents to know more about hostel's events and to discuss their needs, and sweet soup activity (after the residents' meeting). (optional)
- 5.2 Fee charging activities: festival celebrating dinner, and soup activity (optional)

### 7. Application, withdrawal and period of stay

- 7.1 Application
  - 7.1.1 Referrals are made by caseworkers of SWD or NGOs
  - 7.1.2 Standard admission criteria are for all applicants
- 7.2 Withdrawal
  - 7.2.1 All procedures are done by the worker or the resident directly (by oral and or written)
  - 7.2.2 Discharged by hostel for those disobey hostel's regulations (Formal notice is issued by the hostel's social worker)
- 7.3 Period of Stay

Compromised with the referring worker, the resident and the hostel's social worker. Residents can stay no more than 6 months normally. Discretion will be given to those with special difficulties, please contact our social worker.
